

EVERETT E COX – LIFE BLESSINGS

Born 1934, Anadarko, Oklahoma and blessed with great parents. Both parents born in Indian Territory. Bank owning family. Dad played Polo 16 years. Daniel Boone 4th great grandfather on Mother's side. In 1940 moved to 2620 Denniston Drive in Oklahoma City attending second grade at Cleveland grade school, then Taft Jr. High and old Classen High School. While in college at my parents moved to 300 NW 38th street.

- Raised three daughters and step father of two other daughters.
- A number of years of happy married life.
- April, 1947 – Born again Christian (age 13)
- August 1948 – Received amateur radio license- W5OXJ
- 1951 learned to rodeo calf rope – last rodeo 1958, took 2nd place calf roping Guam rodeo.
- 1952 – First Chief control engineer of KOKH-FM, 88.9, “The Radio Voice of the Oklahoma City Public Schools.” (The station and studio were located at the old Classen High School.)
- 1952 – Worked on ranch near Dalhart, in Texas panhandle, part of summer. Experienced old time round up, roping, branding, mountain oysters, etc. (Red Dodson Ranch) Balance of summer Chief Wrangler Triple B Dude ranch with 23 horses, three miles North of Woodland Park, Colorado. Again in summer of 1954.
- 1955 – Bicycled Europe during summer
- September of 1955 in Wildlife Refuge in Wichita Mountains (Oklahoma) with round up club. Especially interesting: One night rode my quarter horse ten miles with full moon to Indian tee-pee Pow-Wow. Participated in friendship circle dance.
- Entire summer of 1956 – Traveled to SE Asia with group of 12 from Oklahoma University led by Professor of Asian History. Stayed with families in various countries there. Operated amateur radio as Maritime Mobile on USS President Cleveland for six weeks across Pacific and return. Introduced to skin diving at Singapore and diving on island of Bali off east end of Java.
- 1956 – Received BBA degree from University of Oklahoma.
- Fall of 1956 – Entered Naval Officers Candidate School, Newport, Rhode Island.
- Spring 1957 – Received Naval Officer Commission USNR as Ensign and sent to Air Ground Officers School, NAS Jacksonville, FL., then Aircraft Maintenance Officers school at NAS Memphis.
- August 1957 – Married to Jan Evans of Oklahoma City
- 1957 – 1960 Guam, Mariana Islands as Lt.(jg) was an Aircraft Maintenance Officer and later Top Secret Control Officer in Air Intelligence with Airborne Early Warning squadron VW-3. Extensive skin diving over 2.5 year period. Operated amateur radio station on Guam including on Navy aircraft in western Pacific. Vacation trips to

Philippines, Japan and Hong Kong. Oldest daughter was born on Guam October 7, 1959.

- Mortgage Banker (Oklahoma Mortgage Company, Inc) from 1960 to 1994 serving as CEO starting in 1974 then mortgage broker specializing in commercial loans until 2007.
- September of 1962 skin dived on old Spanish wreck (the Mantancero) that sank in 1741, the Cox-Myers expedition off Yucatan and retrieved artifacts.
- Starting in 1960, Rented aircraft, then owned four aircraft from 1961-1988 including two Beechcraft Bonanzas, an aerobatic Bi-plane (Christen Eagle II) and a Cessna 421 pressurized turbo-charged twin engine for 16 years. Hold commercial, instrument, single and multi-engine ratings – 5000 hours as pilot in command.
- 1973 acquired part interest in 580 acre tract with a cabin and a 60 acre fishing lake NE of Luther, OK. We enjoyed numerous weekends riding horses and fishing. Sold my interest in 1986.
- 1974-77 Co-developed two Self Storage projects (500 units each) and a 57 unit apartment facility in Tulsa.
- Summer of 1977 took family and three daughters to four of the Hawaiian Islands, Majuro in the Marshall Islands, Ponape and Truk in the Eastern Carolines (Now Micronisa) and to Guam in the Mariana Islands. Skin diving the islands including sunk Japanese ships and plane wrecks in Truk Lagoon.
- Numerous hunting/fishing trips (six to Alaska plus northern British Columbia). In month of July, 1984 spent three weeks alone at cabin on Post Lake in Alaska Mountain Range with six horses. In the various hunts over the years took 2 bear (Black and Brown), two caribou (one Boone and Crocket), Full curl Dall Ram Sheep, Boone and Crocket Moose, Full curl stone sheep in BC. Two antelope (Eastern Colorado and SW Texas). A number of deer in Texas and Oklahoma. Flew many bass fishing trips all over Mexico.
- Skin dived and did SCUBA in six major oceans, traveled to 45 countries.
- March 15, 1978, lost my oldest daughter, age 18.
- June 17, 1978, Baptized with the Holy Spirit at age 44 with speaking in tongues. Saw my first exorcism and learned to do this works of Jesus this year.
- 1979 – Co-purchased 16 story high rise office building (2100 West Loop in Houston) and resold in three months for substantial profit.
- Fall of 1984 formed Deliverance Ministries, Inc. and commenced weekday 15 minute pre-taped radio testimony interview show for 22 years (1984-2006). Also, in 1984 started weekly Monday evening ministry sessions of inner healing and exorcisms using lay Christians who have gone through our training. These ministers come from many different churches. There are over 50 different people each month who come from over the US for ministry, many also receiving physical healings. (Still doing this as I write this in 2013). www.delmin.org

- 1985 acquired get-away cabin 12 miles south of Waynoka, Oklahoma on the south side of the Cimarron river valley in the Glass (Gloss) Mountains with leasing of clear fishing ponds and hunting. Finally selling in 2013.
- 1986 second marriage to Carolyn Boyce, lived in Yukon, Oklahoma 12 years before moving to Edmond in 1997 to present.
- 1988 – Carolyn and I became Amway Directs
- 2008- Carolyn and I did ten day catamaran sailing and skin diving trip with 10 on board including daughter Marla and family in Leeward Islands...had amateur radio equipment. Communicated with many different countries.
- 2010 – Wrote book that was published: “Doing the Supernatural Works of Jesus.” Available on Amazon, Barnes & Noble on line.
- 2011 – Acquired and still own mobile home on Lake Tenkiller in eastern Oklahoma with marvelous deck view of lake.
- Deliverance Ministries is my primary focus and fulfillment today.
