

Morning Prayers for Ministers and Intercessors

Declare and Decree: I declare and decree that every assignment, curse, judgment, hex, vex, voodoo incantation is now broken off of me and my seed today in the name of Jesus Christ.

Accept your Grace: Lord I accept your wonderful gift of Grace and Mercy for me today. I receive the fullness of your Great Grace upon my life. Thank you, Lord Jesus!
