Our focus is doing the SUPERNATURAL works of Jesus.

Our foundation is primarily the New Testament as the new covenant Jesus gave us. We focus on healing the broken hearted, casting out demons, healing the sick and releasing the fullness of the Holy Spirit known as the baptism of the Holy Spirit. We are not a church; therefore, we do not act like the church. However, Jesus said where 2 or 3 are gathered in His Name He is present.

Our format on Monday nights is to have 2 focuses... one where we communicate our process to those coming for ministry; walk through a door closing prayer to close doors to the enemy; then, go through personal, one on one ministry of healing the broken hearted, casting out demons, healing the sick and releasing the fullness of the Holy Spirit known as the baptism of the Holy Spirit.

We are not going to debate the doctrines of many churches because we come from over 160 different types of churches and have ministered to those who have come from all parts of the nation including Hawaii, Maine, Alaska, Washington, etc. We have had one woman come from the Carribean.

The Bible is our source... the Holy Spirit is our power, Jesus is our King and we love Father God, calling on various types of angels to assist in ministry every time. Holy Spirit administrates the angels and we choose to walk in the power of the Holy Spirit each day, letting Him fill us to the full daily.

Our second focus is training. We train individuals in our interview process, the breaking of ungodly soul ties by forgiving, cancelling judgments and letting Jesus heal our hearts; inner healing or healing of traumas in our lives, casting out demons, integrating multiple personalities as Holy Spirit leads, ministering healing in every area of a persons life, releasing blessing in their lives, as well as ministering the baptism of the Holy Spirit to the extent that an individual is receptive.

At any time those coming for ministry or those in training can say I have had as much ministry as I can handle for tonight. We do not coerce or put pressure on individuals who come for ministry. However, those who minister are required to buy into every aspect of ministry that we function in.

At the present time we have 3 leaders for the ministry and as many as 35 active ministers who know how to minister the way we require. We do hold ministers accountable and we do our part to be accountable to Jesus, Father God and the Holy Spirit on an ongoing basis. We have mutual respect and honor for each other in our relationships as we are building a team to do the SUPERNATURAL works of Jesus around the world.

We are simple in our process and anointed to do the works of Jesus. Luke 10.19 is a primary scripture for us and we do our part to walk out each and every part of the New Testament, referring to the Old Testament as our schoolmaster. The Bible and a personal, ongoing relationship with Jesus as our Savior; Father God as our Father, Holy Spirit as our guide and the One who anoints us in the process depending on angels that He would send to help us in the process. There are twice as many angels as there are demons in any given location.
